CHARITY UPDATE

Helping Women Period

A new grant recipient this year is Helping Women Period Chicago. This organization recognized that many homeless and low income women in the area have difficulties getting the feminine hygiene products they need. These items are not covered by SNAP (food stamps) and shelters and food banks rarely receive them as donations.

They feel it's unacceptable that girls and women don't have access to pads, tampons and other sanitary products they need and often as a result have to miss school or work. They know there are often so many challenges these women face in the course of a day and feel this should not be one of them.



This summer they distributed over 8000 products to victims of the flooding in Lake County and 3000 products to girls at a Nicasa backpack event. Both of these were outside of their normal distribution and were made possible by the CWC grant. The grant also will also make it possible for them to increase the distribution to their normal charity partners.


